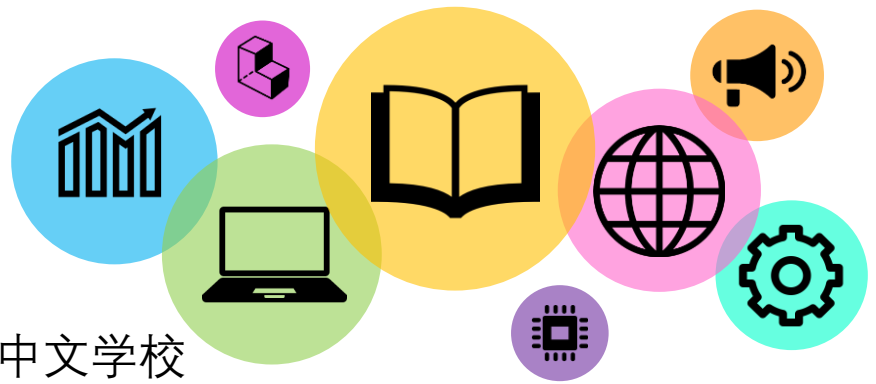

## Business and Money

(Age: 10+)

Want to get into business? How about make money? Business and Money will provide students insight into how the economy functions. Students will learn about supply and demand, what shifts each curve, and therefore why businesses work. Students will also be taught about production possibility curves, gaining insight into entrepreneurship as well as budgeting their own financial assets.

## Introduction to Coding
