I am currently a BCA junior in the AAST academy, and have been closely involved in the competitive mathematics community for the past six years of my life. In middle school, I was placed in an accelerated math program, taking classes with students one grade higher, competed in MathCounts, where I progressed to the state level in eighth grade, taken AMC 8 and earned the Distinguished Honor roll, and participated in the JHMMC, a competition run by BCA students and faculty. After I joined the BCA Math Team in eighth grade, I have competed in the AMC 10 competition, qualifying for the AIME exam in tenth grade, and participated in numerous other contests as a member of the Math Team such as the ARML, Mandelbrot, Lehigh, Purple Comet, Seton Hall, Fall Startup, and HMNT. I also got 800 in the SAT Math II test in this May.

In regards to teaching mathematics, I have volunteered at the BCA Sunday Math Team program this past year, where a few volunteer Math Team members lead a class of middle school students in reviewing and preparing for various contests throughout the year, and had experience with one-on-one tutoring through programs such as YMath.
